SET-UP AND USE



CHECK THE JUICE

All our headphones arrive fully charged, this will give you up to 9 hours of usage. To check the battery level, simply tap the PWR on 'Right' headphone (marked 'R') 4 led bars will illuminate on the power indicator.



FIRE 'EM UP!

Lightly press and hold the PWR button on 'Right' headphone (marked 'R') for 2 seconds to switch on the headphones.



FIND YOUR JAM

Now the headphones are on, lightly tap the CH/LED' to automatically switch between available live channels. The LEDs will change colour if music is being transmitted on multiple channels. (Channel 1 = Red, Channel 2 = Green, Channel 3 = Blue)



CRANK IT (SAFELY OF COURSE)

To adjust the volume to best suit you, simply scroll the volume wheel. We suggest that adults make this adjustment for young children.

NB: You can normally adjust the maximum volume using the device from which you are playing the audio.



SET PARTY MODE

There are 3 LED modes that can be selected, simply scroll through by lightly pressing and holding the 'LED' button on the 'Left Headphone for 2 seconds.

- 1. LED's on-Static illumination
- 2. LED's on- Dynamic illumination
- 3. LED's off

When Dynamic Illumination is selected your headphones will flash to the beat of the music!



AUDIO INPUT

3.5 mm Jack for either audio from a music source or direct input for Microphones. (to ensure compatibility use only TBG supplied Microphones).

- **RCA AUDIO INPUTS**
 - For connection to your music source (laptop, tablet smart phone etc.)
- **POWER SWITCH** For selection of Off / Low Power / High Power Modes.
- Strictly for TBG use only DO NOT CONNECT TO THIS PORT.
- **AUDIO TRANSMISSION ANTENNA**Transmits Audio signal to headphones via RF.


CONNECT ANTENNA

Connect large Antenna to the RF ANT connector on the transmitter and the small antenna to the BT ANT connector.



POWER UP!

Connect the dc power supply provided to the transmitter. The transmitters are supplied fully charged and can run on battery power for up to 5 hrs.



GIVE IT SOME SOURCE

Connect to an audio source using either the provided RCA cables or the inbuilt Bluetooth connection.



DIAL IT IN

Select Transmission Power level (Low (LO) for transmission distance up to ~75m, High (HI) 300 -500m). For Hi power mode the 9V DC power supply must be connected.



GET CONNECTED

BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

- **1.** Keep the Bluetooth device you're trying to connect to within 1m of the transmitter.
- 2. Hold the BT button until a small red dot appears at the bottom right corner of the LCD screen. About 3 seconds later, the red/blue LED blinks alternately in Bluetooth pairing status.
- **3.** Enable Bluetooth on your music device and search for T80 and confirm the Bluetooth connection.
- **4.** After your device has paired with the transmitter, the transmitter will automatically enter standby mode, with the blue led blinking slowly every 5 seconds.
- **5.** Play the music source of your Bluetooth enabled device.



- **1.** Hold the BT button until the red dot at the bottom right corner of the LED display disappears. When in RCA Line-in audio mode the small LED glows red.
- **2.** Connect a cable from the Audio output on your music source to the RCA Audio input located on the transmitter and play music on your device.

CHANNEL YOUR VIBES

Pressing the 'Channel' button changes the channel the transmitter is using. Press to toggle between channels 1,2 & 3. The LED display will show the channel currently selected.

NOTE: When two or more transmitters are working simultaneously, ensure that each transmitter is on a different channel.



SHUT IT DOWN

Ensure Transmitters are turned off after use and pack them back into the hard cases before adding back into your BoomBox.

- POWER ON
 Long press powers the transmitter on/off, short press to exit the menu.
- LED INDICATOR

 Illuminates red when the transmitter is powered on, green whilst charging and off when fully charged.
- CHANNEL SELECTOR +/CH+ / CH- buttons cycle through the transmittion channels (displayed on the LCD screen). When in the settings menu CH+ / CH- navigate up and down through the menus.
- Long press to enter the menu on the LCD screen. When in the menu and a setting has been selected short press to confirm menu selection.

MICROPHONE CONNECTION

Plug the jack from the Microphone headset into the Microphone jack.



WIRED CONNECTION

If you wish to play music tracks at the same time as using the Microphone connect the secondary device via a wired connection or Bluetooth (skip to 2c). Plug the 3.5mm cable from your music device (phone, tablet, laptop, DJ mixer, etc.) into the Line-In port.



BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

Hold the Menu button for 3 seconds, select: BT Mode → On to pair wirelessly. Go to your device's Bluetooth settings and connect to the transmitter.



CHANNEL YOUR VIBES

Select your channel by pressing the CH+ or CH-to toggle through the available frequencies, the channels will be displayed on the LCD screen.

DIAL IT IN (OPTIONAL)

BT Mode: Bluetooth Settings.

Audio Mode: For voiceovers whilst playing music ensure 'HiFi' mode is set to ensure crystal clear voiceovers..

Power: Select High/Low Power mode (affects range and battery life).

Mic DecAudio: Here you can control Microphone voiceovers. Select from three options:

None - two volumes the same

Partial - when Microphone talk, music volume turns down **All** - when Microphone talk, music mute and resume when no talk

ENC: Enable Microphone noise cancelling.



DROP THE BEAT

Press play on your connected device or talk into the Microphone.

Guests can now tune in using their headphones.



TIP: Use High Power Mode for outdoor or large spaces (up to 300m & 10 hours of battery life). Use Low Power Mode for smaller indoor areas or to conserve battery (up to 150m & 25 hours of battery life).

QUICK SETUP

This guide shows you how to activate Auto Mode. Auto Mode runs a continuous cycle through all disco light effects throughout your event, leaving you to join the party.

- Place your light on a stable, flat surface or mount it securely using the hanging bracket.
- Plug in the power cable. The unit will light up and is ready to use.
- Point the Remote to the front of the light and click the top left blue button 'Auto'
- You have three Auto Mode options. Press the same blue button on the remote to scroll through the 3 auto modes and select your preferred option.
- If you want to add the laser, insert the key (attached to the unit), turn it to ON, and the laser effect will activate please reread the laser safety instructions on page 26.
- If you wish to experiment with the other settings (rather than leave on auto) please see options below from the remote. Note: the 'Mix Sound' setting will not be as impactful in a silent disco.


LIGHT REMOTE CONTROL

- 8 Do not open or modify the unit. There are no user-serviceable parts inside.
- Unplug after use and before refilling, cleaning, or moving the unit.

QUICK SETUP

- Position the machine on a level, heat-resistant surface.
- The tank comes ready filled with enough fluid for 2 hours (with short bursts). Do not add any other fluid to the tank.
- 3 Do not overfill or use any flammable liquid.
- Plug in the power cable and ensure the switch on the back is OFF before connecting.
- 5 Turn ON the power switch.
- Wait approx. 3-5 minutes for the device to warm up.
- Press and hold the unlock button on black remote for a few second to release a short burst of fog. Lights can be controlled using the 'lights' remote'.
- If fogging stops when pressing the unlock button on black remote then wait 3-5 minutes for machine to reheat.



TIP: For best results, use short bursts of smoke to build atmosphere gradually



SET-UP AND USE

QUICK SETUP

- Place the machine on a level, dry surface- ideally 1-2 m away from the dancefloor.
- On the front of the bubble machine is a twist knob. This releases a pin which opens up the machine, gaining access to the 'bubble fluid tank/well. Fill the tank with bubble fluid (up to the marked fill line). Do not overfill and be careful when moving machine as the fluid will spill over from the tank/well.
- Plug in the power adapter and switch the unit ON.
- Press the buttons on the remote:



- A Bubbles ON
- Bubbles OFF
- LED ON / press again to change colour

D LED OFF



TIP: Use short bursts for the best continuous bubble flow without emptying the tank too quickly.


AFTER USE

QUICK SETUP

- Place the machine on a flat, stable surface facing the area you want to cover.
- Fill the reservoir with approved snow fluid up to the marked fill line (do not overfill).
- 3 Plug in the power cable to a mains socket.
- Switch ON at the rear of the unit. The machine will warm up for 3-5 minutes.
- 5 Press the button on the remote to start or stop the snow effect.
- 6 For the most natural look, angle the nozzle upwards or across the room.



TIP: Use short bursts every few minutes to maintain consistent snow without overloading the space.

TROUBLESHOOTING

NO MUSIC / AUDIO ON HEADPHONES?

- Check that Headphones are switched on, connected to the correct channel and volume turned up.
- Check that your music playing device is working correctly, playing music and that the volume is turned up on the device.
- Check that the music playing device is correctly connected to the transmitter, ensure the transmitter is turned on and transmitting on the right channel.
- If still no output, try using a different audio device and/or cables with the transmitter
- The headphones will turn off after not receiving a signal from the transmitters for 10 minutes, to stop the transmitters from sending a signal simply turn the switch on the transmitters from HI to OFF.
- Check the headphone/transmitters are within range in open space, typically up to 500m (or up to 300m for the HT003 mobile model). This can be reduced significantly with barriers (walls, metal barriers, subterranean spaces etc). In some cases, elevating the transmitters will help transmission beyond low level barriers.

NO LIGHTS SHOWING ON HEADPHONES?

- If you press and hold the LED button for 2 seconds, it will change the LED (see Page 6 point 5).
- To revert back to the normal LED on setting, press and hold the LED button once or twice for 2 seconds.

INTERFENCE, REDUCED RANGE OR SIGNAL DROP OUT?

- If using two or more transmitters simultaneously, check they are transmitting on different channels. If two are transmitting on the same channel the signals will cancel each other out, giving no or very little signal to the headphones.
- Check there is no interference from other wireless equipment in the vicinity, if operating on similar frequencies this may cause interference.

TRANSMITTER SET-UP

- Check Volume control on the headphone is turned up.
- Check Music Device volume setting is above 50%.
- Check headphone is set to the correct channel that you're playing music from.
- Ensure the Transmitters are each set to different channels.
 - If the transmitters do not turn on check the power cable is connected for 30 minutes before trying again.

FOR THE BG003 MOBILE TRANSMITTER

- Weak or intermittent signal: Move closer to the transmitter, switch to High Power mode, or remove nearby obstructions.
- · Bluetooth not pairing: Enable BT Mode in the menu and make sure the transmitter is visible; unpair any old devices if needed.
- Battery not lasting: Use Low Power mode for extended runtime or fully recharge before use.
- Microphone not working: Confirm the mic is plugged into the Mic Input (not Line-In) and the volume is adjusted.

MUSIC IS COMING OUT DISTORTED

- This could be because the volume on your device (mixer, phone, laptop or audio player) might be too high. Try turning the volume up on the headphones and turning the volume down on the music player a little bit.
- Remove electrical equipment surrounding the transmitter, such as: phone chargers, WIFI Routers, Boosters, Radio Microphones, Walkie-Talkies.
- Make sure there are no power cables going over the transmitter as it can cause electric interference.
- Ensure each of the transmitters are set to separate channels.
- If you're still getting this problem then try relocating the transmitter somewhere clearer and higher.
- Try turning off the Headset, waiting 2 mins and turning back on.

STATIC CAN BE HEARD ON ONE **OF THE CHANNELS**

- You may hear a faint level of static on the channels when no music is playing, this is completely normal and is due to the radio frequency technology the headphones use.
- If you can still hear excessive static after the music is playing, please ensure each transmitter is set to a separate channel, and that no devices in the area are interferina.
- Sometimes the power supply can cause static please try the transmitters on battery mode.

MUSIC PLAYING ON CHANNEL 1 BUT PICKING UP RANDOM NOISES ON CHANNEL 2

- This may be because you have only plugged in 1 transmitter. If you're only using 1 channel, we would advise you to plug in all of the transmitters, even if you don't have any audio going through them.
- This is because the Headphones will try and find the transmitter even if it's not plugged in, they can pick up other signals which may interfere.

Ensure the transmitters are packed in their protective black case. This black case fits inside the Boomboxes as received.


